TITLE: Motion to Approve Increase in Funds to the Structural Engineering Consulting Services Contract with Lakdas/Yohalem Engineering, Inc. – \$220,000

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve an increase in funds to the Structural Engineering Consulting Services, Continuing Contract No. 456-11637 with Lakdas/Yohalem Engineering, Inc. ("Lakdas/Yohalem"), in the total amount of \$220,000.

Background

On July 12, 2016 the City Commission approved the contract award for Structural Engineering Consulting Services Continuing Contract with Lakdas/Yohalem and four other consultants (CAM #16-0740). The contract was renewed for an additional twelve-month period, expiring on July 11, 2019; one renewal option is remaining.

After the implementation of the contract, it was determined that the original cap of \$131,000 would be exceeded by the Public Works Department during the first renewal term. Transportation and Mobility Department staff is requesting this increase for needed work to the City Park Garage/Riverwalk Center. The site would need a detailed structural condition survey, detailed repair design documents and monitoring the structural repair (post design) services to provide sustainable building structure and provide public safety.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$220,000 for this increase.
