## **RESOLUTION NO. 18-**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, CHANGING THE NAME OF THE PARK LOCATED AT 200 SISTRUNK BOULEVARD (N.W.  $6^{\text{TH}}$  STREET), FROM "SISTRUNK PARK" TO "CARLTON B. MOORE PARK".

WHEREAS, the Mayor's office requested City staff evaluate changing the name of "Sistrunk Park", located at 200 Sistrunk Boulevard (N.W. 6<sup>th</sup> Street), to "Carlton B. Moore Park" in honor of former City of Fort Lauderdale City Commissioner Carlton B. Moore; and

WHEREAS, consistent with the Naming Parks, Recreation Areas and Major Facilities Policy adopted by the City Commission on December 20, 2011, Parks and Recreation staff evaluated the request and determined that the suggested name has merit for discussion; and

WHEREAS, the Parks, Recreation and Beaches Advisory Board, at its June 27, 2018 meeting, recommended approval of changing the name of "Sistrunk Park" located at 200 Sistrunk Boulevard (N.W. 6<sup>th</sup> Street) to "Carlton B. Moore Park"; and

WHEREAS, City staff notified surrounding homeowners associations of the proposed name change and posted sign notices on the park property; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission has determined that the suggested name change meets the guidelines of the Naming of City Parks, Recreation Areas and Major Facilities policy;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The park located at 200 Sistrunk Boulevard (N.W. 6<sup>th</sup> Street) previously named "Sistrunk Park" shall be named "Carlton B. Moore Park" in honor of former City of Fort Lauderdale City Commissioner Carlton B. Moore.
