TITLE: Motion to Approve Contract for Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport Western
Perimeter Loop Road – Stanford & Sons Trucking Corporation d/b/a
Stanford Construction - \$864,216

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a contract, in substantially the form attached, for the Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport Western Perimeter Loop Road Project with Stanford & Sons Trucking Corporation dba Stanford Construction in the amount of \$864,216.

Background

Currently, vehicles and aircraft on the west side of the airport have to cross Runway 9 in order to relocate the aircraft/equipment to the areas north of the runway. These crossings affect the tower operations, airfield traffic, and increase the possibility of unauthorized incursions. An asphalt perimeter road will be constructed along the western end of Runway 9 to minimize these crossings and to enhance the safety of airport operations. The work includes milling, subgrade, limerock and asphalt paving; pavement striping and sodding. The design was completed by HDR Engineering, Inc., the Airport's consulting engineer.

On February 23, 2018, the Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid Number 12112-683. Eight bids were received on April 4, 2018, and all bids were reviewed for compliance with the solicitation specifications. Based on the results of the background checks, the lowest bidder, Stone Concept Miami Inc., is deemed non- responsible and is not recommended for award. The bid submitted by the second lowest bidder, Stanford Construction, was reviewed for compliance with the specifications of the bid, and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive, and responsible bidder recommended for award.

Resource Impact

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$864,216 for the contract award and \$157,322 for estimated consultant and in-house project management fees for a total of \$1,021,538. Funds for this item in the total amount of \$1,021,538 are available in the FY 2018 Budget and Community Investment Plan in the accounts listed below:
