TITLE:	Motion to Authorize the Execution of a Site Access Agreement with Broward County in Order to Demolish and Abandon Pump Station A-44

#### **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission authorize the execution of a Site Access Agreement with the Broward County Facilities Division (Exhibit 2), for the purpose of entering Broward County property to perform the demolition and abandonment of pump station A-44.

#### **Background**

Pump Station A-44 is a City-owned and operated sanitary sewer pump station that has provided sanitary sewer service to the Broward County Homeless Assistance Center from its inception. The Center is located at 920 NW 7 Avenue, Fort Lauderdale, Florida, 33311 (Exhibit 1).

During the City WaterWorks 2011 Program, a sanitary sewer system was constructed in the neighborhood surrounding the Center. Due to the availability of this sewer service, it is no longer necessary for the City to operate and maintain Pump Station A-44, and the station must be demolished. Sanitary sewer service to the Homeless Assistance Center will be provided by construction of a new sewer lateral connection. Construction of the new sewer lateral will be a part of the demolition project for the pump station.

### Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City for this action.

### **Strategic Connections**

This item is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018* initiative, included within the Infrastructure Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:

- Goal 2: Be a sustainable and resilient community.
