

RESOLUTION NO. 18-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, TO APPLY TO THE BROWARD BOATING IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR A REIMBURSABLE GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF FIFTY THOUSAND (\$50,000) AND NO/100 DOLLARS FOR FUTURE ABANDONED AND DERELICT VESSEL REMOVAL; FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS NECESSARY OR INCIDENTAL TO THE APPLICATION FOR THE GRANT, GRANT AGREEMENT, GRANT ACCEPTANCE, RECEIPT AND DISBURSEMENT OF GRANT FUNDS PURSUANT THERETO.

WHEREAS, the City responds to complaints regarding abandonment and / or derelict vessels in the City's waterways; and

WHEREAS, many times these abandoned and / or derelict vessels have sunk and pose navigational and environmental hazards to the City's waterways; and

WHEREAS, removal of derelict vessels will serve a valid municipal purpose and is in the best interest of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Broward Boating Improvement Program (hereinafter "BBIP") has reimbursable grant funding for up to \$50,000 for the purpose of removal of derelict vessels from waterways within the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for a grant from Broward County under the Broward Boating Improvement Program ("BBIP") in an amount not to exceed \$50,000 for the removal of abandoned and derelict vessels from the City's waterways, together with any and all instruments for documents.

SECTION 2. That the Office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents hereunder prior to their execution by the City Manager.

SECTION 3. That any and all Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage
