THIRD AMENDMENT TO

INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

BROWARD COUNTY

and

CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE

for

COMMUNITY BUS SERVICE

This is a Third Amendment to the Agreement, made and entered into by and between BROWARD COUNTY, a political subdivision of the state of Florida, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY",

AND

CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, a municipal corporation existing under the laws of the state of Florida, its successors and assignees, hereinafter referred to as "CITY".

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale (the "City") entered into an Interlocal Agreement ("ILA") on November 3, 2014 with Broward County (the "County") to provide community bus services within the City; and

WHEREAS, on June 10, 2015, the City and County entered into a First Amendment to the ILA to modify certain terms of the Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on May 11, 2018, the City and County entered into a Second Amendment to the ILA to modify the service hours and funding for existing routes; and

WHEREAS, the ILA was extended for one (1) year and will expire on September 30, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City and Broward County wish to extend the ILA for a second one (1) year term ending on September 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, this Third Amendment to the ILA is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the public.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual terms and conditions, promises, covenants and payments hereinafter set forth, COUNTY and CITY agree as follows:

- 1. The above recitals and representations are true and correct and are incorporated herein.
- 2. Article 5, Term and Time of Performance of Agreement, Section 5.1 of the ILA is hereby amended as follows:
 - 5.1 The term of this Agreement shall begin retroactive to October 1, 2014 and shall end on September 30, 2017; the term may be extended for up to two (2) additional one (1) year renewal periods upon written approval of the Contract Administrator ninety (90) days prior to the expiration date of the current term. The continuation of this Agreement beyond the end of any fiscal year shall be subject to both the appropriation and the availability of funds in accordance with Chapter 129, Florida Statutes.
- 3. The term of the ILA shall be extended for one (1) year commencing on October 1, 2018 up to and including September 30, 2019.
- 4. The Third Amendment to the ILA shall be effective upon full execution by the parties.
- 5. The Third Amendment to the ILA may be fully executed in multiple copies by the parties each of which, bearing original signatures, shall have the force and effect of an original document.
- 6. In the event of any conflict or ambiguity by and between the terms and provisions of this Third Amendment to the ILA, the terms and provisions of this Third Amendment to the ILA shall control to the extent of any such conflict or ambiguity.
- 7. The terms and conditions of the ILA, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect, except as specifically amended herein.
