TITLE: Resolution to Accept a Grant in the amount of \$7,500 from Broward County
to Assist in the Financing of a 9/11 Memorial Statue at Riverwalk

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution to accept a grant from Broward County in the amount of \$7,500.00, to assist in the financing of a 9/11 memorial statue, and authorize the City Manager to execute an Agreement with Broward County to accept the grant funds and any other documents necessary for acceptance of such funds.

Background

On September 11, 2001 nearly 3,000 lives were lost as a result of a terrorist attack on the United States. Riverwalk Fort Lauderdale, Inc. has initiated a capital campaign to support a 9/11 memorial statue. The monument will serve as a memorial of the lives lost on September 11, 2001 and will commemorate the lives and the sacrifice of the families and the first responders. The monument will be displayed in the Riverwalk District for neighbors and visitors to observe. A brochure detailing the monument is attached as Exhibit 1.

Resource Impact

There is a positive impact to the City in the amount of \$7,500.00. Funds were appropriated through CAM #18- 0225 on July 10, 2018. There is no match required for this grant.
