- **TITLE:** Resolution to Approve a 1) An Eleventh (11th) Amendment to the Memorandum of Agreement with the Florida Department of Transportation for Installation and Maintenance of Landscape and Hardscape Improvements within the Right-of-Way on the East Side of A-1-A between NE 22 Street and NE 23 Street and, 2) Assumption of Liability and Hold Harmless Agreement with PRH Fairwinds, LLC

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing the proper city officials to execute: 1) an Eleventh (11th) Amendment to the Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement (Exhibit 1) with the Florida Department of Transportation for landscape and hardscape improvements within the right-of-way on the east side of A-1-A between SE 22nd Street; and SE 23rd Street and, 2) an Assumption Agreement, in substantially the form attached, with PRH Fairwinds, LLC (PRH) (Exhibit 2).

Background

The City of Fort Lauderdale will enter into an eleventh (11th) Amendment to the Maintenance Memorandum of Agreement (MMOA) with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) relative to the installation and maintenance of landscape and hardscape improvements, which will include: nine shade trees with various shrubs/groundcover and architectural concrete pavers along A-1-A (North Ocean Boulevard) for the Auberge Beach Residences and Spa development located at 2220 N. Ocean Boulevard, subject to certain terms and conditions defined in Exhibit 1. The Assumption Agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale and PRH passes the maintenance responsibility and costs associated with the MMOA to PRH. PRH agrees to hold the City harmless from any obligations pertaining to any of the improvements installed by them, in the right-of-way.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.
