## Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a motion to authorize execution of a Revocable License with Autonation, Inc., in substantially the form attached, for the construction of a temporary beach statue at Las Olas Boulevard and A1A.

## Background

Autonation, Inc. has requested to construct a temporary beach statue in the shape of a pink ribbon to promote Breast Cancer Awareness during the month of October. Organizers have requested to place the beach statue, attached as Exhibit 1, on A1A and Las Olas Boulevard from Monday, September 24, 2018 to Monday, November 5, 2018. The design of the ribbon is the same as approved by Commission last year.
