**TITLE**: Motion to Approve Contract for Purchase of Plumbing Services and

Maintenance – Pipeline Plumbing Services of Broward, Inc. - \$620,000

#### Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a one-year contract, in substantially the form attached, for the purchase of plumbing services and maintenance from Pipeline Plumbing Services of Broward, Inc. (Pipeline) in the estimated annual amount of \$620,000; and authorize the City Manager to approve three, one-year renewal options contingent upon appropriation of funds.

# **Background**

This plumbing and maintenance services contract is vital to the Facilities Maintenance Section. It provides support in the area of major troubleshooting, repair and replacement, after-hour emergencies, and instances when the City's Plumber is over burdened with daily work orders. The City's aging infrastructure and high use demand placed on facilities require constant service and attention and will be provided through this contract.

The Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No. 12142-583 and received three bids. The bid submitted by Pipeline has met all of the specifications of the bid and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder.

### **Resource Impact**

There will be no fiscal impact to the City in FY 2018. Future expenditures are contingent upon approval and appropriation of the annual budget.

## **Strategic Connections**

This item is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018* initiative, included with in the Public Places Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:
