

RESOLUTION NO. 18-155

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS TO EXECUTE AN INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT WITH BROWARD COUNTY FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE 100-YEAR FLOOD ELEVATION MAP AND ASSOCIATED MODELING; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the 100-year Flood Elevation Map and the associated modeling which is used to mitigate flood risk in developed areas through regular of design criteria such as flood elevations has not been updated since 1977; and

WHEREAS, the COUNTY has agreed to contribute a fifty (50%) percent fund, with the remaining fifty (50%) percent being contributed by ten (10) local government partners that Broward County has identified as willing to cost share; and

WHEREAS, the County has entered into an agreement with Geosyntec Consultants, Inc., to develop the 100-year flood map and the associated modeling with a one (1) year projected timeline; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:


SECTION 1. That the City Commission approves the Interlocal Agreement for the development of the 100-Year Flood Elevation Map and Associated Modeling, and authorizes execution of same.

SECTION 2. That the proper City officials of the City of Fort Lauderdale ("City") are hereby authorized to execute an Interlocal Agreement between Broward County and the City for the development of the 100-year Flood Elevation Map and Associated Modeling.

SECTION 3. That the office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
