- TITLE: Motion to Approve an Assignment of Revocable License Agreement Between 315 Flagler, LP and 315 Flagler Owner, LLC

#### **Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a motion authorizing the City Manager to execute an Assignment of Revocable License Agreement between 315 Flagler, LP and 315 Flagler Owner, LLC.

### **Background**

On June 28, 2018 the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale approved a Revocable License Agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale and 315 Flagler, LP for pedestrian/shoulder closure in connection with the development of the hotel project at 315 Flagler Avenue.

As part of the underwriting conditions the construction lender requires that 315 Flagler, LP form a new entity called 315 Flagler Owner, LLC which will become the owner and the borrower. 315 Flagler Owner, LLC is a wholly owned subsidiary of 315 Flagler, LP. 315 Flagler Owner, LLC is a single purpose limited liability company of which 315 Flagler, LP is the sole member, meaning there is no change of control of the ownership of the project. A deed was recently recorded so that the title now vests in 315 Flagler Owner, LLC, and that is the entity that will be the borrower and mortgagor under the construction loan documents.

#### Resource Impact

There is no new fiscal impact associated with this action.
