TITLE: Resolution to Approve the Execution of a Revised Interlocal Agreement
with Broward County for the Transportation System Surtax

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a revised Interlocal Agreement, in substantially the form attached, with Broward County for the Transportation System Surtax.

Background

At its meeting of September 4, 2018, via Commission Agenda Memo 18-0960 (Exhibit 1), the City Commission approved the execution of an Interlocal Agreement (ILA) with Broward County for the Transportation System Surtax. On September 12, 2018, Broward County informed all of its municipalities, via email (Exhibit 2), that some cities may not have considered/approved the correct version of the ILA; Fort Lauderdale was one of those cities.

The following revisions were made to the ILA (Exhibit 3):

Section IV - MPO Review and Ranking

- The MPO's obligation under this paragraph shall be subject to: (a) the County and MPO entering into an agreement for the County to fund, from Transportation Surtax Proceeds (as defined below), the MPO's actual, reasonable costs of meeting this obligation; and (b) the County, MPO, and Municipalities representing a majority of the population of Broward County entering into a separate agreement to establish the methodologies and criteria pursuant to which the MPO will review, rank, and prioritize the applicable projects.

E. Community Bus Service

- The Transportation Surtax Proceeds will be used to directly fund ~~the~~ all reasonable and necessary operating, maintenance, and capital costs of existing Community Bus Service and improved or new Community Bus Service, subject to the following conditions and subject to such expenditures being approved by the Oversight Board.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action

This is a Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018 initiative, included within the Infrastructure Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:

- Goal 1: Be a pedestrian friendly, multi-modal City.

- Objective 2: Integrate transportation, land use, and planning to create a walkable and bikeable community.
- Objective 3: Improve pedestrian, bicyclist, and vehicular safety.
