TITLE: Ordinance Amending the Funding of the Affordable Housing Trust Fund

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission amend the Affordable Housing Trust Fund (AHTF) Ordinance No. C-16-30 to include language for an additional funding source to support affordable, attainable or workforce housing.

Background

In 2005, the City received a \$350,000 contribution from a developer to the City's Affordable Housing Trust Fund for delivery of affordable housing units. On October 6, 2015, the City Commission approved by resolution an Affordable Housing Policy which included a recommendation from the Affordable Housing Advisory Committee (AHAC) to establish an Affordable Housing Trust Fund. The Affordable Housing Trust Fund was established by Ordinance on January 4, 2017.

On July 10, 2018, a joint workshop between the City Commission and the AHAC discussed applying fifteen percent (15%) of the net proceeds from the sale of City owned non-residential (commercial/industrial) properties into the AHTF, in addition to 100% of the net proceeds of residential property sites. All funds in the in the AHTF shall be used for eligible housing trust fund activity. The current balance of the AHTF is \$764,755.

Resource Impact

There is no current fiscal impact associated with this CAM.

Strategic Connections

This item is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018* initiative, included within the Neighborhood Enhancement Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:

- Goal 5: Be a community of strong, beautiful, and healthy neighborhoods.
