Brief Project Summary: On occasion, the City responds to a complaint regarding an abandoned boat or derelict vessel. Many times they have sunk are a navigational hazard and/or an environmental hazard. As these situations arise, the City will gather bids for removal and disposal of the vessel and the seek reimbursement from other granting agencies such as the Florida Navigation District. This program is different in that if awarded, it is a line credit to be drawn down over the life of the grant. There is no match required on approved projects. Once approved, the City would dispose of the vessel and seek reimbursement. If the grant funds are exhausted prior to the end of the 4-year term, the City can reapply to receive additional funding for another 4-year term.

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Major Conditions and Deliverables: The Broward Boating Improvement Program (BBIP) provides funding for the removal and disposal of derelict vessels that meet these criteria: A vessel that has been abandoned by the owner and is creating a navigational hazard by blocking or intruding into a navigational channel, or creating an environmental hazard. Vessels that are behind private property or at a private marina or dock are prohibited from being removed using BBIP funds. Prior to removal of a boat that meets the criteria above, the City must receive approval from either the Broward County Sheriff's office of Mr. John Fiore.
