Execution of a Supplemental Joint Participation Agreement with Florida Department of Transportation for Construction of the Administration

Building Expansion at Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission accept an additional \$129,995 in grant funding from the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) for the construction of the Airport Administration Building expansion at Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport (FXE), and approve a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a Supplemental Joint Participation Agreement (SJPA) on behalf of the City.

Background

This project is for the improvement and expansion of the Fort Lauderdale Executive Airport Administration Building. The improvements will include new landscaping and irrigation, parking improvements and light-emitting diode (LED) lights. The improvements also include energy efficient heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) units. In addition, a new conference room and office spaces will be constructed to accommodate meetings and enhanced staffing requirements.

The existing facility was constructed in 2002 with office space, conference room, a backup emergency operations center (EOC) and a Fort Lauderdale Police Department substation. Since that time, there have been significant improvements in the HVAC and lighting systems. These new systems will reduce maintenance and energy usage once implemented in the building. The addition of a new conference room will continue to serve as a back-up EOC with state-of-the-art technology enhancements to meet City needs. The existing conference room will be converted to office space. The installation of Florida friendly landscaping will also assist in reducing water usage.

Based on the engineers estimated project cost of \$1,000,000, FDOT provided a Joint Participation Agreement (JPA) in the amount of \$800,000 for the projected construction costs on August 4, 2017. FDOT has agreed to provide a Supplemental Joint Participation Agreement (SJPA) in the amount of \$129,995 for additional funding needed due to the

project bid proposals exceeding the engineer's original estimate. The grant match amount of \$25,999 is available in the project budget.

The Aviation Advisory Board supported staff's recommendation to approve the (SJPA) at its meeting of September 27, 2018.

Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$129,995 for the grant revenue contingent upon approval and appropriation of the October 9, 2018 Consolidated Budget Amendment CAM #18-0530. The required grant match of \$25,999 is available in the project budget.
