TITLE: Discussion on New Fort Lauderdale Police Department Headquarters

At the City Commission's Joint Workshop with the Infrastructure Task Force (ITF) held on October 10, 2018, a workshop was requested for the purpose of discussing the funding of a new headquarters facility for the Fort Lauderdale Police Department.

For discussion purposes, it is estimated that debt service on a \$100 million General Obligation with level debt and a 30-year amortization would be \$5,769,000. Using the current value of a mill, debt service would be 0.165 mill. This would translate to \$49.50 per year on a single-family home with a taxable value (after homestead exemption) of \$300,000.
