Memorandum of Understanding Trailer Amendment

It is hereby acknowledged that the equipment listed below was acquired utilizing South Florida Local Emergency Planning Committee (SoFlaLEPC)/South Florida Regional Planning Council (SFRPC) Hazardous Materials Emergency Planning (HMEP) Grant Funds. While such grant funds are managed by SoFlaLEPC/SFRPC, they are administered through the Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) and ultimately approved and provided by the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT). The trailer specifications were recommended by the State Emergency Response Commission (SERC) Training Task Force and consequently selected by the SoFlaLEPC.

This is an Amendment to the existing Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Fort Lauderdale Fire Rescue Department (FLFR) and SoFlaLEPC/SFRPC (Attachment 1). The purpose of the Amendment is solely to add the trailer listed below to the existing agreement.

Manufacturer: Load Runner Trailers

Purchased: September 2018 Cost: \$5,200.00 (approximately)

The Amendment term and conditions remain the same as the existing MOU (Attachment 1), with the following stipulations:

 FLFR will provide general maintenance and storage for the trailer as well as the annual registration/tag. FLFR will be responsible for the costs associated with restoring (or replacing) this resource if damaged while training in-house.
