**TITLE:** Resolution Creating a City Manager Search Committee

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**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution creating a City Manager Search Committee.

**Background**

The City Commission wishes to create a search committee to assist the Commission in its search for a new City Manager. The purpose and duties of the City Manager Search Committee include advising the City Commission on matters related to the hiring of a City Manager, consider community concerns and recommendations, and review resumes provided by an outside consultant and prepare a short list of candidates for review. A more detailed list of the Committee's purpose and duties is more clearly defined in the attached resolution (Exhibit 1).

The City Manager Search Committee will exist from the date of its creation until abolished by resolution of the City Commission.
