TITLE: Resolution in Support of the City of Wilton Manors' NE 26th Street
Improvement Project

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution in support of the City of Wilton Manors' NE 26th Street Improvement Project from Dixie Highway to US-1 (also known as State Road 5).

Background

In 2016, the City of Fort Lauderdale Commission passed a resolution 16-09 (Exhibit 1) in support of Wilton Manors' Complete Streets and Localized Initiatives Program (CSLIP) application for the addition of bike lanes on NE 26th Street from Dixie Highway to US-1. The project has design programmed in FY 2020.

In order for the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) to begin its work on this project, FDOT requires an updated resolution with additional language stating that the City endorses FDOT to fully administer the design and construction phases of the project, on behalf of the City. This language has been added to the attached resolution (Exhibit 2).

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.

Strategic Connections

This item is a *Press Play Fort Lauderdale Strategic Plan 2018 initiative*, included within the Infrastructure Cylinder of Excellence, specifically advancing:

- Objective 1: Improve transportation options and reduce congestion by working with agency partners
- Objective 3: Improve pedestrian, bicycle, and vehicular safety
