**TITLE:** Motion to Approve Contract for Purchase of Industrial Painting Services –  
J&J Inc. d/b/a Eagle Painting - \$700,000 (two-year total)

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a two-year contract, in substantially the form attached, for the purchase of industrial painting services from J&J Inc. d/b/a Eagle Painting (“Eagle”), in the estimated two-year total amount of \$700,000 and authorize the City Manager to approve two, one-year renewal options, contingent upon appropriation of funds.

**Background**

This contract is to provide materials, labor and equipment required to paint various buildings and other structures within the City. In addition, it includes cleaning and applying protective coatings to maintain the durability and aesthetic quality of City facilities.

The Procurement Services Division issued Invitation to Bid No. 12194-593 and received eight bids. The bid submitted by Eagle has met all of the specifications of the bid and has been deemed the lowest cost, responsive and responsible bidder.

**Resource Impact**

There will be a fiscal impact to the City in the estimated amount of \$350,000. Future expenditures are contingent upon approval and appropriation of funds.
