

RESOLUTION NO. 18-233

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING AN AMENDED JOB CREATION SCHEDULE FOR CONTENT CRITICAL SOLUTIONS, INC. ("PROJECT DELTA"), A QUALIFIED TARGET INDUSTRY BUSINESS PURSUANT TO SECTION 288.106, FLORIDA STATUTES, PROVIDING FOR CONFLICTS, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in accordance with Resolution 16-104, on July 12, 2016, the City of Fort Lauderdale approved local financial support in the amount of \$9,000, for Content Critical Solutions, Inc. ("Project Delta"), a Qualified Target Industry Business pursuant to Section 288.106, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, in the original application for a Qualified Target Industry Business, Project Delta committed to start its hiring expansion in 2017; and

WHEREAS, Project Delta has requested that the original job creation schedule be delayed for a year so that Project Delta may begin its hiring expansion in 2018; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity has advised that it will accept the revision to the job creation schedule, all terms remaining the same, if the City of Fort Lauderdale approves the delay of the job creation schedule;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:


SECTION 1. The foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct, and are incorporated herein by this reference.

SECTION 2. That the City Commission hereby approves the amended job creation schedule for Content Critical Solutions, Inc. (Project Delta) to begin its hiring expansion in 2018, with 2019 being the first year that Project Delta is eligible for Qualified Target Industry Business incentive payment from the City.

SECTION 3. All parts of Resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 4. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
