RESOLUTION NO. 18-235

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF THE BROWARD METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION'S ONE-WAY STUDY FOR ANDREWS AVENUE AND 3RD AVENUE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 4, 2018, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("BMPO") presented the concept of creating one-way pairs utilizing Andrews Avenue and 3rd Avenue within the downtown regional activity center; and

WHEREAS, the concept included creating a more efficient intersection and traffic flow by reducing the number of signal phases and creating dedicated transit-only lanes with additional space for pedestrians and bicycle infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, Andrews Avenue and 3rd Avenue are within Broward County Rights-of-Way in the City of Fort Lauderdale; and

WHEREAS, and the project will be presented to the Broward County Commission for a resolution of support; and

WHEREAS, once a Broward County resolution is passed, the agencies will work together to determine the methodology and funding sources for a transportation study and to understand costs and benefits to design alternatives; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale will be responsible for an estimated cost of \$75,000.00, as the City's share for the overall traffic study expense;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida hereby supports the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization's project to move into the study phase of the Downtown One-Way Pairs Concept to include Andrews Avenue and 3rd Avenue.
