

RESOLUTION NO. 18-235

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF THE BROWARD METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION'S ONE-WAY STUDY FOR ANDREWS AVENUE AND 3<sup>RD</sup> AVENUE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on September 4, 2018, the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization ("BMPO") presented the concept of creating one-way pairs utilizing Andrews Avenue and 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue within the downtown regional activity center; and

WHEREAS, the concept included creating a more efficient intersection and traffic flow by reducing the number of signal phases and creating dedicated transit-only lanes with additional space for pedestrians and bicycle infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, Andrews Avenue and 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue are within Broward County Rights-of-Way in the City of Fort Lauderdale; and

WHEREAS, and the project will be presented to the Broward County Commission for a resolution of support; and

WHEREAS, once a Broward County resolution is passed, the agencies will work together to determine the methodology and funding sources for a transportation study and to understand costs and benefits to design alternatives; and


WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale will be responsible for an estimated cost of \$75,000.00, as the City's share for the overall traffic study expense;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida hereby supports the Broward Metropolitan Planning Organization's project to move into the study phase of the Downtown One-Way Pairs Concept to include Andrews Avenue and 3<sup>rd</sup> Avenue.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
