A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA DELEGATING TO THE CITY MANAGER THE AUTHORITY TO ACCEPT SUB-GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$31,003.68 PROVIDED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY, URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE AND TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO ACCEPT SAID FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security (USDHS) has provided financial assistance to the Miami urban area in the amount of \$4,921,000 through the Fiscal Year 2017 Urban Area Security Initiative (USAI) Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the "urban area" is defined as the City of Miami and the City of Fort Lauderdale (City) collectively; and

WHEREAS, the City has received a sub-grant in the amount of \$31,003.68 with no required match;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA THAT:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That City Manager is delegated the authority to accept sub-grant funds from the United States Department of Homeland Security and the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management in the amount of \$31,003.68 and to execute any documents required to accept said funds.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the Office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by City officials.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon and after its passage.
