Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a motion authorizing the execution of a dockage facility use agreement with Winterfest, Inc., for New River/Riverwalk dockage facility for use as staging for the 2018 Winterfest Boat Parade on December 15, 2018.

Background

This is a request for authorization to enter into a dockage facility use agreement with Winterfest, Inc., for payment of fees to the City in the amount of \$2,429.79 representing the loss of revenue resulting from the required vacation of vessel-occupied slips during the Winterfest Boat Parade. The fees are associated with the staging of vessels and spectator viewing on the New River and Riverwalk for the 2018 Winterfest Boat Parade.

Resource Impact

There is a positive fiscal impact in the amount of \$2,429.79. Revenue related to this agreement is included in the FY 2019 operating budget in the account listed below.
