Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution approving the City of Fort Lauderdale's 2019 State Legislative Priorities and Funding Requests.

Background

The City's lobbyists, Ericks Consultants, Inc., Ronald L. Book, PA., and The August Company, LLC will assist the City with lobbying efforts at the State level. These firms, along with staff, will be advocating for City's interests during the upcoming legislative session. Through this resolution, the Commission provides direction to City staff, lobbyists and other interested parties as to the official position of the City of Fort Lauderdale regarding issues, pending legislation and funding requests that would affect the operation of local government. In addition, throughout the upcoming year, staff will seek grant funding for projects and programs that the Commission has prioritized.

The attached document articulates the City of Fort Lauderdale's 2019 State legislative priorities and funding requests based on the discussion and presentation from the Commission Conference Meeting of December 4, 2018.
