**TITLE:** Motion to Approve a License Agreement between the City of Fort  
Lauderdale and The School Board of Broward County for Shared Use of  
Sunrise Middle School Pool

---

**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a motion to renew a license agreement between the City of Fort Lauderdale and The School Board of Broward County for shared use of the Sunrise Middle School pool.

**Background**

On November 10, 1998, the City of Fort Lauderdale and The School Board of Broward County entered into a twenty (20) year license agreement for shared use of the Sunrise Middle School pool. The original agreement is set to expire on January 11, 2019.

The City desires to enter into a license agreement for another twenty (20) years, with the School Board of Broward County.

Terms of this agreement are as follows:

- This License Agreement shall commence on January 12, 2019 and end on January 11, 2039.
- During the SBBC regular school year, the SBBC shall have use of the pool during the hours school is in session including after school activities and after child care programs. Such hours shall be Monday through Friday, from 7:00 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. and the City is granted rights to have use of the pool, Monday through Friday from 6:30 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. and on SBBC recognized school holidays, and weekends from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., unless the SBBC requires use of the pool during the cited hours.
- The City is granted rights to use the pool during the SBBC recognized Summer months and dates, Monday through Sunday, from 7:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m., exclusive of the SBBC usage if any, during the cited Summer hours.

**Resource Impact**

There is no fiscal impact associated with this item.

**Strategic Connections**
