**TITLE**: Resolution Calling Special Election; Charter Amendments

## Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution calling a special election for March 12, 2019, and establishing a procedure for placing ballot measures on the March 12, 2019, special election ballot that, if passed, would amend the Charter of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida.

## **Background**

The proposed resolution would authorize the Broward County Supervisor of Elections to place two ballot measures on a March 12, 2019, special election ballot. If both questions are approved by a majority of the electors of the City of Fort lauderdale, the measures would amend Article III, Government of City and Form of Government, and Article VII, Elections, and various other provisions of the Charter of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida.
