Communication to City Commission

Your Education Advisory Board has created a City of Fort Lauderdale Education Assessment to present to you during a City Commission Education Workshop. In this EAB assessment, we took a data-informed approach and conducted a gap analysis to show the most pertinent gaps for K-12 education for City residents. For the gaps identified in our assessment, we prepared a list of recommendations for the Fort Lauderdale City Commission to take in

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conjunction with other recommended actions for the Broward County Public Schools and the Broward County School Board. We are confident that these City Commission actions, which we hope will be done as part of a renewed partnership between the City and Broward County Public Schools and the Broward County School Board can dramatically improve the K-12 education offered to City residents. We further believe that closing or eliminating the current gaps in education will lead to improvement in the general well-being and economic prosperity of the City of Fort Lauderdale. We request a 2-hour City Commission Workshop be scheduled within the next 60 days with three objectives: to share our City of Fort Lauderdale Education Assessment, to share the associated recommendations, to enable your consideration of our recommendations and to get your guidance for our future EAB efforts.
