

RESOLUTION NO. 19-

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA FOR ELECTRONIC ACCESS TO THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF HIGHWAY SAFETY AND MOTOR VEHICLES' DRIVER AND VEHICLE INFORMATION DATABASE.

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale's Transportation and Mobility Department's Parking Services Division requires electronic access to the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles' Driver and Vehicle Information Database System ("DAVID") to obtain information for use in the collection of parking citation fines, parking enforcement and permitted parking; and

WHEREAS, a Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") between the City of Fort Lauderdale and the State of Florida was executed on June 29, 2017 for the purpose of allowing the City access to DAVID; and

WHEREAS, the "deceased date" of an individual is provided by the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles through the DAVID application and obtained from the National Technical Information Service (NTIS) and NTIS Limited Access Death Master File (DMF); and

WHEREAS, the NTIS requires the compliance with certain Federal Regulations related to the deceased date of an individual; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale received correspondence from the State of Florida advising that the executed MOU is being amended, pursuant to Section VIII of the MOU, to include additional NTIS requirements regarding the deceased date of an individual provided in the DAVID application;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute an amendment to the Memorandum of Understanding with the State of Florida for electronic access to the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles' Driver and Vehicle Information Database System on behalf of the City of Fort Lauderdale.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
