

RESOLUTION NO. 18-271

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF BROWARD COUNTY POSTING "NO THRU TRUCKS" SIGNAGE AT THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTHWEST 25TH AVENUE AND THE SOUTHERN RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF DAVIE BOULEVARD, IN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Broward County Traffic Engineering Division ("BCTED") has recommended that a "No Thru Trucks" sign be posted at the intersection of Southwest 25th Avenue and the southern right-of-way line of Davie Boulevard, in the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, in an effort to enhance public safety in that residential area due to neighbor complaints of continuous commercial truck traffic; and

WHEREAS, in response to neighborhood complaints, City staff conducted a field investigation and determined that commercial truck traffic traveled on Southwest 25th Avenue, south of Davie Boulevard, to access Riverland Road; and

WHEREAS, Southwest 25th Avenue, south of Davie Boulevard, is a residential roadway and is not suitable for commercial truck traffic; and

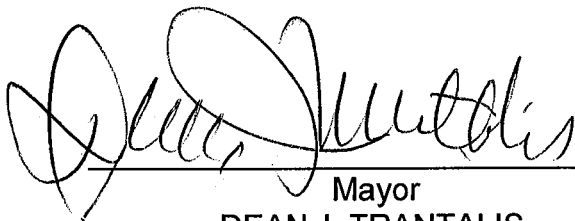
WHEREAS, a formal resolution from the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, is required by Broward County in order for the new sign to be installed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, hereby supports the installation of a "No Thru Trucks" sign at the intersection of Southwest 25th Avenue and the southern right-of-way line of Davie Boulevard, in the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida, in order to enhance public safety in that residential area.

SECTION 2. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
