TITLE: Traffic Signal System Assessment

The City's Neighbor Survey asks our neighbors to rate their "Satisfaction with the Overall Flow of Traffic" in the City of Fort Lauderdale. In our latest survey, the satisfaction was the lowest to date, with only 15% saying they were very satisfied or satisfied. Following that result, staff was asked to hire a consultant to research the current state of the signal system within the City limits, determine what it would take to take over signal control in Fort Lauderdale, and to research what technologies could be implemented beyond the current system to improve operations and satisfaction.

This is the first presentation by the City's consultant, Kittelson & Associates, to describe the current state of the City's traffic signal system and present three scenarios to improve traffic flow for our neighbors through variable investment and resources.

The Transportation and Mobility Department is seeking feedback from the City Commission on the preferred scenario.
