

RESOLUTION NO. 19-12

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, SUPPORTING THE 10-MINUTE WALK TO A PARK CAMPAIGN LAUNCHED BY THE TRUST FOR PUBLIC LAND, NATIONAL RECREATION AND PARK ASSOCIATION AND URBAN LAND INSTITUTE, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN A LETTER IN SUPPORT THEREOF.

WHEREAS, in October 2017, the Trust for Public Land ("TPL"), the National Recreation and Park Association ("NRPA"), and the Urban Land Institute ("ULI") launched the 10-Minute Walk Campaign to celebrate, recognize and highlight cities, mayors, and other civic leaders that promote the "10-Minute Walk to a Park", which is a movement with a goal to ensure that every person across America is within a 10-minute walk to a park; and

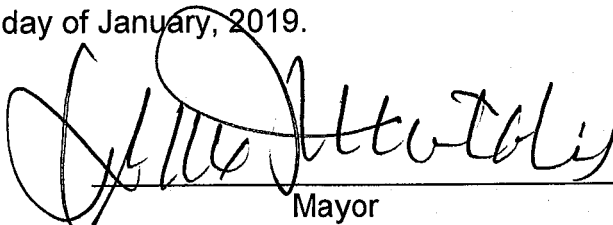
