TITLE: Motion to Approve Ranking of Firms, Negotiated Fee Schedule and
Contract Award for Breakers Avenue Streetscape Project – Kimley-Horn
and Associates, Inc. – \$700,000

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission award a contract, in substantially the form attached, to Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. for Breakers Avenue Streetscape Project at an estimated cost of \$700,000.

Background

The goal of the Breakers Avenue Streetscape project is to create an iconic corridor that not only provides transportation mobility options but is also a climate-resilient and sustainable City asset. At the same time, enhancing economic investment and provides safe, accessible space that works as an outdoor gathering area for residents and people visiting our beach. Services include engineering design and construction administration services.

The background of the solicitation process included the following:

- In November 2018, the Procurement Services Division issued Request for Qualifications ("RFQ") No. 12226-996 – Breakers Avenue Streetscape Project.
- In December 2018, the RFQ closed with the five firms below submitting proposals:
 - Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. ("Kimley-Horn")
 - Wantman Group, Inc. ("Wantman")
 - Keith and Associates, Inc. ("Keith")
 - Chen Moore and Associates, Inc. ("Chen Moore")
 - WSP USA Inc. ("WSP")

- On January 14, 2019, the following four firms were shortlisted:
 - WSP
 - Chen Moore
 - Kimley-Horn
 - Wantman
- On January 24, 2019, presentations were held with the shortlisted firms and the four firms were ranked as follows:
 - Kimley-Horn
 - Chen Moore
 - WSP
 - Wantman

Negotiations have been completed and staff recommends award to the first ranked firm, Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. at the negotiated hourly rates identified in Exhibit 1 of the contract.

Resource Impact

There will be a current fiscal year impact to the City in the amount of \$700,000 for the contract award. Funds for this purchase are available in the account listed below.
