TITLE: Motion to Approve Increase in Funds to Contract for Fire Protective

Clothing - Bunker and Bail-Out Gear - Fisher Scientific Company L.L.C. -

\$137,191

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve an increase in funds to contract No. 872-11923 for Fire Protective Clothing - Bunker and Bail-Out Gear, with Fisher Scientific Company L.L.C. ("FSC") in the amount of \$137,191.

Background

On September 19, 2017, the City Commission awarded Contract No. 872-11923 to FSC in the amount of \$296,613 (CAM 17-1028). The contract term is two years plus two one-year renewal options.

Firefighter protective clothing ("bunker gear") is the most important equipment that will ensure the protection for our firefighting personnel during fire related incidents/responses. Bunker gear provides thermal protection from the excessive heat experience in responding to fire related incidents. For optimal thermal protection, each set of bunker gear is custom fit for each firefighter.

Due to the addition of more Fire-Rescue personnel (not contemplated at the time the contract was originally entered into) and replacements for equipment with excessive wear and tear in advance of the maximum life expectancy, an increase to the current contract amount is needed.

Staff is now requesting a \$137,191 increase to protect new fire fighters with necessary equipment and to replace bunker gear that is reaching its life expectancy. Procurement Services was able to negotiate a 6% discount for this additional equipment.

Resource Impact

There will be a current fiscal impact to the City in the amount of \$137,191. Funds for this action are available in the account listed below.
