TITLE: Motion to Approve a Parking Enforcement Agreement with 955 S. Federal
LLC, Inc.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission authorize the City Manager to enter into an agreement, in substantially the form attached, with 955 S. Federal LLC, Inc. to monitor and enforce parking at its designated lot location through the use of the City's Parking Enforcement Agreement.

Background

This agreement provides the City and 955 S. Federal LLC, Inc. the opportunity to build a partnership that provides public parking and promotes uniform parking requirements in its parking lot located at 500 SE 9th Street. The lot offers general public parking.

This is a one-year agreement with four one-year renewals. The City will enforce all parking ordinances within this lot pursuant to Chapter 26 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Fort Lauderdale. The City will monitor the parking lot and will retain all citation and enforcement revenue.

Resource Impact

There will be a positive impact associated with this agreement for any citation revenue generated.
