**TITLE:** Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Execute Annual Certifications  
and Assurances to the Federal Transit Administration

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**Recommendation**

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to complete and execute annual pre-award Certifications and Assurances to the Federal Transit Administration ("FTA") for the purpose of applying to receive grant funding.

**Background**

Before the FTA may award federal grant funding to the City of Fort Lauderdale, to support a public transportation project, an authorized representative must complete the required pre-award Certifications and Assurances relevant to the application and bind the applicant's compliance. These Certifications and Assurances are pre-award requirements, generally required by Federal law or regulation, and must be re-submitted each fiscal year that a grant application is submitted to the FTA. An example of the Certifications and Assurances document is attached as Exhibit 1.

**Resource Impact**
