TITLE: Resolution Authorizing the City Manager to Execute Annual Certifications

and Assurances to the Federal Transit Administration

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution authorizing the City Manager to complete and execute annual pre-award Certifications and Assurances to the Federal Transit Administration ("FTA") for the purpose of applying to receive grant funding.

Background

Before the FTA may award federal grant funding to the City of Fort Lauderdale, to support a public transportation project, an authorized representative must complete the required pre-award Certifications and Assurances relevant to the application and bind the applicant's compliance. These Certifications and Assurances are pre-award requirements, generally required by Federal law or regulation, and must be resubmitted each fiscal year that a grant application is submitted to the FTA. An example of the Certifications and Assurances document is attached as Exhibit 1.
