TITLE: Motion to Terminate for Convenience Contract No. 12089-183 for Holiday
Park War Memorial Auditorium Renovations – Canseco Electrical
Contractors, Inc.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission terminate for convenience, Contract No. 2089-183 with Canseco Electrical Contractors, Inc. ("Contractor") for renovations including electrical and lighting system replacement at the Holiday Park War Memorial Auditorium ("WMA").

Background

On June 19, 2018, the City Commission awarded Contract No. 12089-183 for renovations including electrical and lighting system replacement at the WMA in the amount of \$842,100 (CAM 18-0510).

In an effort to save resources until the City had completed its re-valuation of the future use of the WMA, the Procurement Services Division issued a Notice to Suspend Work on November 1, 2018 and a Notice of Intent to Terminate Contract on January 24, 2019.

At this time, staff recommends the City Commission terminate the contract for convenience. This action will allow the City to execute a public/private partnership agreement to renovate the facility for an ice skating and special events facility. The Contractor will be submitting the final invoice for all approved and completed work.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City for this action.
