Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve a Temporary Access Agreement with the School Board of Broward County and authorize execution of the agreement by the City Manager (Exhibit 1).

Background

The Temporary Access Agreement is required by the School Board of Broward County, to grant access of City Contractor to School Board property, more specifically the New River Middle School, for the demolition and abandonment of wastewater Pump Station C-3.

The school's sewer system has been directly connected to the Riverland Area sewer collection system. The direct connection has eliminated the need for Pump Station C-3. Pump Station C-3 is inactive and must be demolished and abandoned.

Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact to the City.
