RESOLUTION NO. 19-37

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING RATIFYING A BETWEEN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE AND TEAMSTERS LOCAL UNION 769. AFFILIATED WITH INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF TEAMSTERS, TO IMPLEMENT A TASK TIME SYSTEM IN THE PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT'S BULK TRASH DIVISION, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXERCISE THE CITY'S OPTION TO EXTEND THE TASK TIME SYSTEM IN SIX-MONTH INTERVALS, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Manager of the City of Fort Lauderdale and the bargaining agent of Teamsters Local Union 769, affiliated with International Brotherhood of Teamsters, have reached agreement on a Memorandum of Understanding for a Task Time System for employees assigned to the Bulk Trash Division in the Parks and Recreation Department; and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Lauderdale employees who are members of the bargaining unit represented by Teamsters Local 769, affiliated with International Brotherhood of Teamsters, have ratified the Memorandum of Understanding;

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That the Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Fort Lauderdale and Teamsters Local Union 769, affiliated with International Brotherhood of Teamsters, is approved and ratified in substantially the form attached to Commission Agenda Memo No. 19-0217, and the City Commission authorizes the City Manager to execute the Memorandum of Understanding.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the City Manager is authorized to exercise the City's option to extend the Task Time System in six-month intervals as provided in Section 2 of the Memorandum of Understanding. The City's option unilaterally to discontinue the Task Time System as provided in Section 13 of the Memorandum of Understanding is subject to approval by the City Commission.

SECTION 3. That this Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon final passage.
