TITLE: Cemetery Master Plan Presentation

This presentation is informational and is intended to provide an opportunity to receive input from the City Commission on the Cemetery Master Plan Study.

Paul Weinberg of Keith, the City's Design Consultant, will be making a presentation to the City Commission which will include an overview of the planning process, trust fund analysis, site plan concepts, recommendations and next steps, attached hereto as Exhibit 1.

The Master Plan project will produce a long-range planning document to assist the City of Fort Lauderdale in managing the preservation and future development of the four municipally owned cemeteries. This plan examines the current condition of historical, cultural, natural and built resources within each cemetery; identifies and prioritizes challenges and needs; recommends treatment options; and presents a guide for implementing those recommendations.

City staff, together with the Cemetery System Board of Trustees met with Keith over the past several months to provide feedback on various planning aspects of the study.

At its March 6, 2019 meeting, the Cemetery Board of Trustees passed a motion to accept the Cemetery Master Plan report. Upon receipt of comments, the final report will be presented to the City Commission for acceptance at its meeting on April 16, 2019.
