Pursuant to the City of Fort Lauderdale Ordinance No. C-15-01, the applicant held a public participation meeting with the Flagler Village Civic Association ("FVCA") and the Victoria Park Civic Association ("VPCA"), which are the only two officially-recognized civic associations located within 300' of the Application.
