City of Fort Lauderdale Transportation and Mobility Division staff have reviewed and approved the Traffic Impact Study (TIS) submitted February 6<sup>th</sup>, 2019 and revised March 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019. The proposed 629 Residence project is a mixed used development and will consist of 249 Residential Units, 1,300-square-feet of commercial space on the subject property. Access to the site will be provided via a driveway off of SE 5th Ave. The TIS was prepared by Kimley-Horn.
