A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA DELEGATING TO THE CITY MANAGER THE AUTHORITY TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT URBAN AREA SECURITY INITIATIVE FY 2018 BETWEEN THE CITY OF MIAMI AND THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE FOR SUB-GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$172,313.00 PROVIDED BY THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY AND ACCEPTANCE OF SAID FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security (USDHS) has provided financial assistance to the Miami urban area in the amount of \$5,700,000.00 through the Fiscal Year 2018 Urban Area Security Initiative (USAI) Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the "urban area" is defined as the City of Miami and the City of Fort Lauderdale (City) collectively, and

WHEREAS, the City has received a sub-grant in the amount of \$172,313.00 with no required match;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. That City Manager is delegated the authority to accept a grant from the United States Department of Homeland Security and the State of Florida Division of Emergency Management and execute the required documents between the City of Miami and the City of Fort Lauderdale, specifically a Memorandum of Agreement Urban Area Security Initiative FY2018 in the amount of \$172,313.00.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by City officials.
