TITLE: Motion to Approve Increase in Funds for Purchase of Irrigation Supplies –
Various Vendors - \$50,000

Recommendation

It is recommended that the City Commission approve an increase in funds for the purchase of irrigation supplies from various vendors, in the total amount of \$50,000.

Background

On May 17, 2016, the City Commission awarded Contract No. 562-11721, on behalf of the Southeast Governmental Purchasing Cooperative Group (CAM 16-0514). The awarded amount for Fort Lauderdale was \$180,000. The contract term is two years plus two one-year renewal options; and is currently on its first renewal which expires on July 1, 2019.

The contracted vendors are:

Quigar Electric Inc. d/b/a Ace Pump & Supply
Bee Electric Motor Repair
Core & Main LP f/k/a HD Supply Waterworks, Ltd.
Melrose Supply & Sales Corp
Rice Pump and Motor Repair, Inc.
Siteone Landscape Supply, LLC

Effective October 1, 2018, the City of Fort Lauderdale assumed the responsibility and operations management of the City's four cemeteries. Additional irrigation supplies are now needed at all the cemeteries to make essential repairs to the irrigation systems.
