## <u>Recommendation</u>

It is recommended that the City Commission adopt a resolution declaring the official intent of the City of Fort Lauderdale to reimburse itself from bond proceeds for funds advanced by the City for certain capital expenditures for police and public safety expenses incurred with respect to the acquisition, construction, development, extensions, enlargement, improvement, renovation, equipping and furnishing of police and public safety facilities.

#### **Background**

On March 12, 2019, Fort Lauderdale voters approved bond referendums to issue GO Bonds to finance the acquisition, construction, renovation and improvement of police and public safety facilities.

This resolution is being adopted to comply with certain requirements of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, that govern the process for such reimbursements.

#### Resource Impact

There is no fiscal impact associated with this action.
