A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA DELEGATING TO THE CITY MANAGER THE AUTHORITY TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY (USDHS) THROUGH THE PREPARING COMMUNITIES FOR COMPLEX COORDINATED TERRORIST ATTACKS (CCTA) GRANT PROGRAM 2016 BETWEEN THE CITY OF MIAMI AND THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE FOR SUB-GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$15,600.00 AND ACCEPTANCE OF SAID FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security (USDHS) has provided financial assistance to the Miami regional area in the amount of \$723,260.00 through the Fiscal Year 2016 Preparing Communities for Complex Coordinated Terrorist Attacks (CCTA) Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the CCTA Grant Program 2016 been defined as the City of Miami and the City of Fort Lauderdale (City) collectively, and

WHEREAS, the City will receive a sub-grant in the amount of \$15,600.00 with no required match;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That City Manager is delegated the authority to accept a grant from the United States Department of Homeland Security and execute the required documents between the City of Miami and the City of Fort Lauderdale, specifically a Memorandum of Agreement Program to Prepare Communities for Complex Coordinated Terror Attacks Grant Program 2016 in the amount of \$15,600.00.

<u>SECTION 2</u>. That the office of the City Attorney shall review and approve as to form all documents prior to their execution by City officials.
