A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AGREEMENT BETWEEN MARTY KIAR, AS BROWARD COUNTY PROPERTY APPRAISER, AND THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF NECESSARY ADMINISTRATIVE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE FORT LAUDERDALE UNDERGROUNDING UTILITY LINE NON-AD VALOREM ASSESSMENT TAX ROLLS FOR PROPERTIES WITHIN THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on February 19, 2019, the City Commission adopted a resolution of intent to use the uniform method of collecting a non-ad valorem assessment for costs associated with utility undergrounding; and

WHEREAS, Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, requires the taxing authority levying a non-ad valorem assessment and electing to use the uniform method of collecting such assessment to enter into a written agreement with the Property Appraiser for reimbursement of necessary administrative costs incurred; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission of the City of Fort Lauderdale, Florida desires to execute an agreement with Marty Kiar as Property Appraiser to include on the assessment roll the Fort Lauderdale Undergrounding Utility Line Assessment commencing with the 2019 assessment roll:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF FORT LAUDERDALE, FLORIDA:

<u>SECTION 1</u>. The City Manager is authorized to execute an agreement between Marty Kiar, as Broward County Property Appraiser, and the City of Fort Lauderdale for the Non-Ad Valorem Assessments known as Underground Utility Line Assessment commencing with the 2019 assessment roll.
